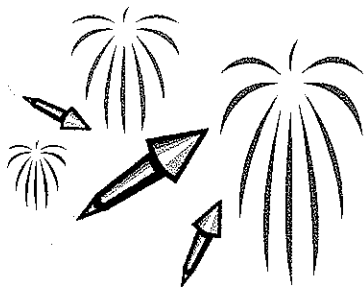
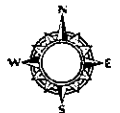
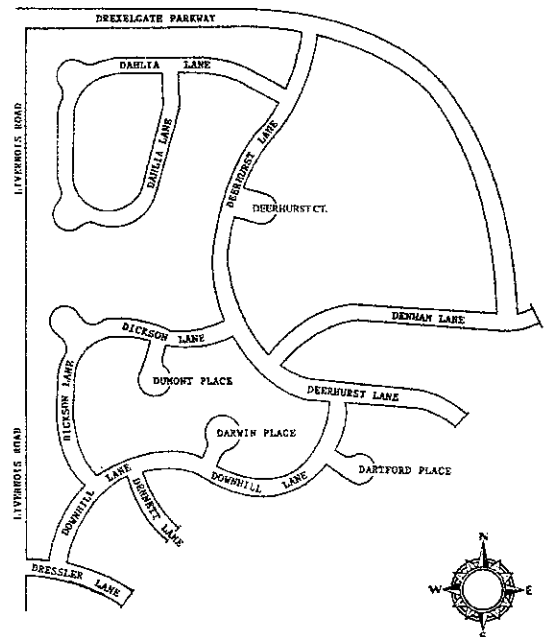
HERE WE ARE! Sound familiar?

ON THE ROAD

One of the most beautiful places to visit this season is the Tahquamenon Falls State Park in the UP. It's on M-123 between Paradise & Newberry. There are two hiking trails, one in the Upper Falls and one in the Lower Falls. You can do both in the same day because the largest one is the Lower Falls, that is about 1 mile long. If you want to spend few days in this area, there are campgrounds and picnic areas in the Lower Falls surroundings. There is one vehicle entry fee for both upper and lower falls parking lots and there is also a boat rental fee in the Lower Falls if you want to do the Island Trail over there.

Bookmobile from the Rochester Hills Public Library

Every Monday from 3:30 to 4:30 pm the Rochester Hills Public Library Bookmobile will be stopping at Avon Hills Co-Op. The bookmobile features 160 square feet of usable space and houses some 3,000 books, videos, DVD's, Cd's and other items. Additional features include a fold-out ramp for easy access, a retractable awning, exterior lighting and an exterior sound system. Satellite communications and cell phone technology allow for connectivity to the Internet and the Main Library's catalog.

This new service starts September 11, 2006 at 3:30 and will run year round. The bookmobile will be parked by the Co-Op office on Drexelgate. Bring proof of residency if you need to obtain a library card.
